As a Founding Partner, your organization will have the opportunity to recognize and support exceptional organizations through **Leadership Growth Scholarships** while helping establish the first scholarship-supported 360 Leadership Groups.



Provide **\$4,950** of scholarship value through a **\$2,500** Founding Partner investment,

WHY LEADERSHIP GROWTH SCHOLARSHIPS?

Leadership Growth Scholarships are not intended to provide free participation. Rather, they recognize organizations whose leadership demonstrates a commitment to growth, improvement, and excellence.

Recipients are selected based upon **both the value they are expected to receive** from participation **and the value they are expected to contribute** to the group experience.

The scholarship is not a handout. It is recognition.

Each Leadership Growth Scholarship represents a shared commitment among an exceptional organization, a Founding Partner, and Texas Consilium.

Because all parties invest in the process, all parties share a vested interest in success.

SCHOLARSHIP DESIGNATION OPTIONS

Partner Nomination

Founding Partners may nominate a **for-profit or nonprofit organization** whose leadership team would benefit from participation and whose experience, perspective, and commitment to excellence would strengthen the group experience.

Examples may include clients, prospects, referral relationships, community organizations, charitable nonprofits, emerging growth companies, and established organizations pursuing greater performance.

Texas Consilium Candidate Profiles

Texas Consilium may also present qualified candidate organizations identified through assessments, referrals, events, outreach efforts, and existing relationships. Founding Partners may review anonymous profiles and elect to recognize and support an organization through a Leadership Growth Scholarship.

Initial Scholarship Designation: \$2,500

Additional Scholarship Designations: \$2,000 each

Many Founding Partners may choose to support multiple organizations through additional scholarship designations. Because recognition and administrative costs are largely established through the initial designation, additional scholarships may be designated at a reduced investment.
